OLD GUILDFORDIANS' RUGBY FOOTBALL CLUB.

Since its formation in October of last year the Rugby Football Club can claim to have progressed very favourably. The playing membership at present amounts to thirty-two, and it is hoped that this number will be considerably increased by next season. There is no limit to the number of new members needed.
